FACTS ON THE HIGH SCHOOL DIVISION

BACKGROUND:

This is the 24th annual high school division of the "End of the Oregon Trail". Last year this tourney was a sellout and from the early interest it will fill even quicker this year. Players can only be from your high school area. No pick-ups are allowed. This is the top high school tourney (non-all-star) on the coast.

COST:

\$295.00 PER TEAM

TIMES:

First round games for Tourney will begin Friday June 19th. Every team will play on the 20th. We will finish in the afternoon on Sunday, June 21st. Some Washington school will be still in school on the 19th so we will allow them to play later games on 19th if they request it on their entry form.

AWARDS & TROPHIES:

First through sixth team award and Consolation team trophy
MVP first and second place team
15 All-Stars
Individuals for first place team

RULES:

- A. Games will be split into two 16 minute halves. Time will be 16 minute stop time.
- B. 3 minute overtime if game ends in a tie.
- C. 7 fouls before team goes into bonus.
- D. 6 fouls will disqualify a player.
- E. We may use a shot clock this year at some gyms. There is an over and back line and a ten second count in backcourt.
- F. All other OSAA high school rules will be followed
- G. Every team will be guaranteed 4 games
- H. Mercy rule: Team attend by 25 points or more with 5 minutes left in game Clock will run for remainder of game except during timeouts.

Programs will be made available so spectators will get to know your players. We need a list of probable participants as soon as possible. You may add to this list up to your first game. Send a tentative roster with your check. Also include a brief summary of your team and top players.
